

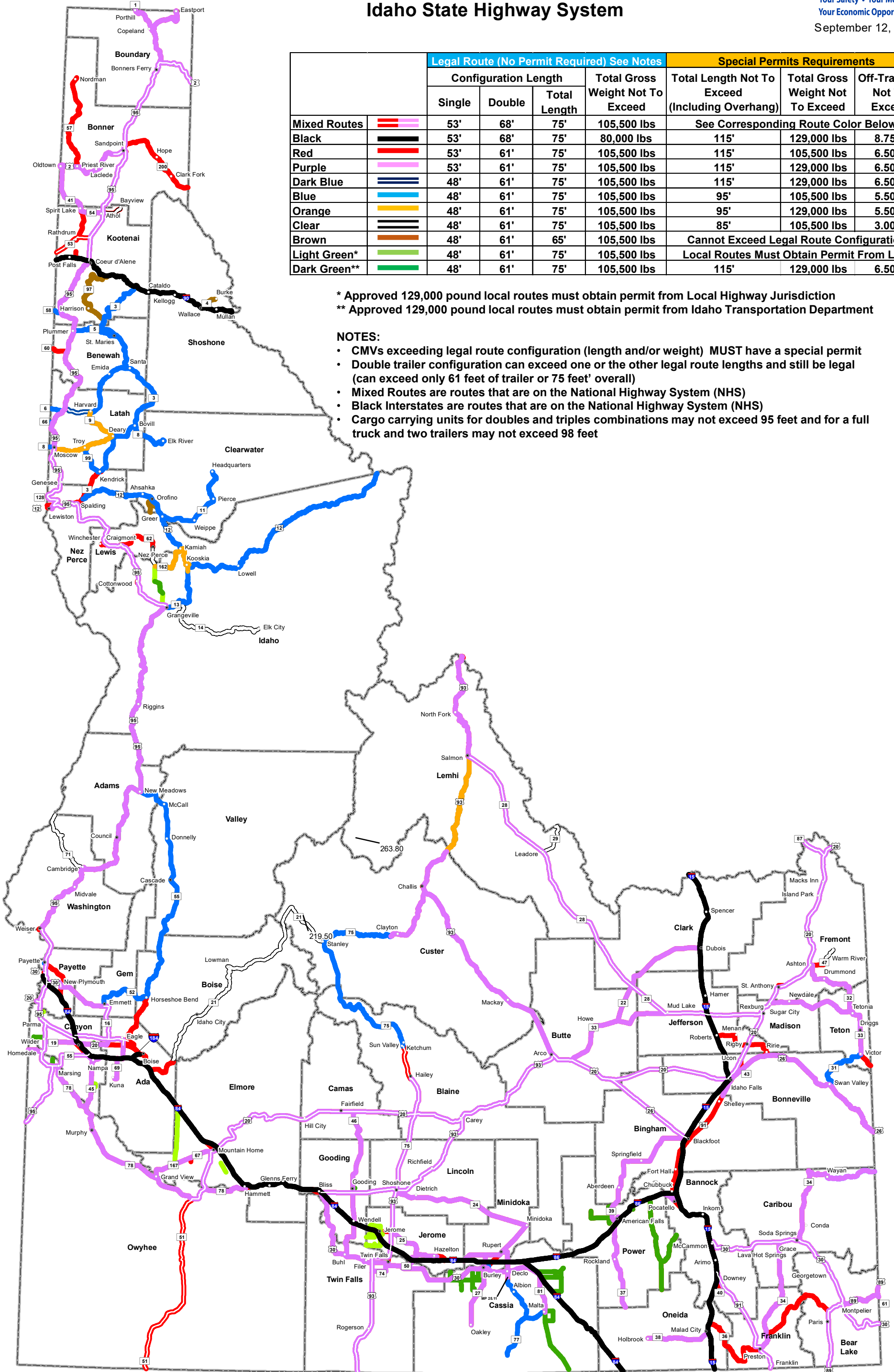

NOTES:

- CMVs exceeding legal route configuration (length and/or weight) MUST have a special permit
- Double trailer configuration can exceed one or the other legal route lengths and still be legal (can exceed only 61 feet of trailer or 75 feet' overall)
- Mixed Routes are routes that are on the National Highway System (NHS)
- Black Interstates are routes that are on the National Highway System (NHS)
- Cargo carrying units for doubles and triples combinations may not exceed 95 feet and for a full truck and two trailers may not exceed 98 feet
